By-Law No. LXXXIII

To reunite School Sections No 6 and 22 in the Township of Augusta

Whereas this Council has been duly petitioned by the Trustees of School Section No 6 and also by the Trustees of School Section No 22, in behalf of Public Meetings held in School Section No 6 on the 5th day of November 1853, and in School Section No 22 on the 22nd day of April 1853, and composed of the Household-ers, and Freeholders in said School Sections respectively and expressing a desire to be reunited into one School Section.

Be it therefore ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta duly assembled at the house of Trustees Stone on the 19th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three, that the above named School Sections Numbers six and twenty two in the Township of Augusta, shall on and after the twenty fifth day of December 1853 be reunited into one School Section, to be numbered and called School Section Number six in the said Township
