

Be it further ordained and enacted that it shall be the duty of the Collector for the Township to collect the said sums at the same time and in the same manner as other taxes are collected, and shall pay over forthwith said monies to the Treasurer of the Township, to be by him paid to the Trustees of the said School Sections on their orders or orders for the same subject however an additional sum of four per cent upon the said sums so to be assessed levied and collected, and to be assessed levied and collected in like manner in the said School sections and to be retained by the Treasurer to be applied to the general uses of the Township for the expenses of collecting the same

By Law No. XXXV

To raise a certain sum in the Township of Augusta to defray the current expenses of the Township for the year 1855

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta duly assembled at the house of Erasmus Stone on the 7th day of May in the year of our Lord 1855, that there be assessed levied and collected by the several Officers whose duty it shall be to assess levy and collect the same on the rateable property in the Township for the current year to defray the expenses of the Municipal Corporation, the sum of Seventy five pounds Currency
