

By-Law No. CXVIII.

For the purpose of appointing a committee to superintend the building of a Town Hall for the Township of Augusta and for other purposes therein mentioned.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta duly assembled at the House of Benjamin S. Throop in said Township, on Tuesday the 11th day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight, that the proposal of Mr John Bishop in reference to one half acre of land situated on the rear half of the centre commons in the fifth concession of the said Township on the corner opposite the House of Benjamin S. Throop for the site of a Town Hall, be accepted by this Council, and that John Hill, Charles Law, Charles Row, George Russell and William Garay, be appointed a building committee to have full power to advertise for tenders, get plans and specifications, let out the said Town Hall to build by contract, borrow monies necessary - pay out the same and do whatsoever they may deem just and right in reference to the building of said Town Hall and also secure the title forthwith.
