

By-Law No. CXXIV

To repeal By-Law Numbers 113 and 116 entitled By-Law "It repeals By-Law Number twenty nine, entitled By-Law to repeal By-Law Number thirty three entitled By-Law to repeal a part of sections seven of By-Law Number five, entitled By-Law to define and prescribe the duties of the following Township Officers Viz: Assessor, Collector, Overseer of Highway and Pound Keepers, acting under the authority of the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta."

I. Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, duly assembled at the Town Hall of said Township on Tuesday the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, that said By-Law Numbers 113 and 116 fixing the amount of commutation money for statute labour in this Township at one Shilling and nine pence per day be repealed, and the same is hereby repealed.

II. Be it further ordained and enacted that any By-Law or parts of By-Law repealed by the said By-Law Numbers 113 and 116 do stand repealed as they were before the passing of this By-Law.
