By Law No. XXXII.

To repeal By Law Number 102 and for other purposes therein mentioned.

Be it ordained and enacted, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augustus duly assembled at the Town Hall on Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, that By Law Number 102 entitled "By Law for raising a certain sum of money belonging to the Municipality of the Township of Augustus, and devoting the proceeds thereof to Educational purposes" be repealed, and the same is hereby repealed.

Be it further ordained and enacted, that the interest arising from the money known as the "Savings Reserve Fund" belonging to the Municipality be equally divided among the School Sections in this Municipality and said interest shall be apportioned equally by the Local Superintendent of Common Schools for this Municipality, and paid over annually at such time as the Municipal assessment is paid to all School Sections where a school has been kept open at least six months previous to the time of the said payment in each year, provided always, that each Union School Section shall not receive only one half of the amount apportioned to each whole School Section in this Township.
