

By Law 175.

To raise a certain sum of money to defray the lawful and necessary expenses of the Township, for the current year 1863.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augustus assembled at the Town Hall, on Monday, the 18th day of May, 1863, that there be levied and collected on the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township, to pay the expenses thereof, the sum of eight hundred and sixty dollars

Be it further ordained and enacted that the said sum of eight hundred and sixty dollars, be apportioned by the Township Clerk, on all the assessed real and personal property aforesaid, and placed on the Collectors Roll for the Township, and when the said sum of money shall have been placed on the said Roll, the Collector of the Township shall proceed to levy and collect the said rates or sums of money, in the same manner as is now provided by law, for the collection of any other rates, and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township, to be by him paid out agreeable to the order of the Municipal Council of this Township.
