

By Law No. 190.

To raise a certain sum of money for the support of the poor, residing in the Township of Augusta.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, assembled at the Town Hall on Tuesday the seventeenth day of January 1865. that there be levied and collected on the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township for the support of the poor, residing therein, the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars currency.

Be it further ordained and enacted that the said sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be apportioned by the Township Clerk on all the assessed real and personal property aforesaid and placed on the collectors Roll for the Township and when the said sum of money shall have been placed on the said Roll, the Collector of the Township shall proceed to levy and collect the said rates or sums of money in the same manner as is now provided by law, for the collection of any other rates, and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township, to be by him paid out applicable to the order of the Municipal Council of this Township.
