

By-Law No. 198

To raise a certain sum of money to defray the lawful and necessary expenses of the Township for the current year.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, assembled at the Town Hall on Thursday the thirty first day of August 1865, that there be levied and collected on the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township, to pay the expenses thereof the sum of eleven hundred and fifty dollars.

Be it further ordained and enacted, that the said sum of eleven hundred and fifty dollars be apportioned by the Township Clerk on all the assessed real and personal property aforesaid, and placed on the Collectors Roll for the Township and when the <sup>said</sup> sum of money shall have been placed on the said Roll, the collector of the Township shall proceed to levy and collect the said rates or sums of money in the same manner as is now provided by law, for the collection of any other rate, and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township, to be by him paid out agreeable to the order of the Municipal Council of this Township.
