

By Law No. 202.

For limiting the Number of Houses of Public Entertainment  
in this Municipality and for other purposes therein  
mentioned

Whereas the following petitions have been laid  
before this Council viz. the Petition of John Chapman  
and 26 others, praying that Hiram Mc Bellamy in the  
Village of North Augusta, be granted a Tavern License  
Petition of George Mc Henry and 40 others praying  
that Charles Eldridge of the Village of Maitland, be  
granted a Tavern License - Petition of Joel Briggs and  
31 others, praying that William Humphreys of the Village  
of North Augusta be granted a Tavern License - Petition  
of Durham Jones and 38 others praying that Elizabeth  
Dumbrell of the Village of Maitland be granted a Tavern  
License - Petition of A. Newell and 30 others praying  
that William Mc Meahon at Guy Corners, be granted  
a Tavern License, and the said petitions were all signed  
by the number of Municipal Electors required by law.

Be it ordained and enacted by the  
Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, assembled  
at the Town Hall on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1866.  
that the said petitions be granted and that the number of  
Houses of Public Entertainment to be licensed in this Township  
shall not exceed five in number, and that the Inspector  
of Licenses shall not grant more than five Certificates for  
licenses in this Township for the current year.
