

By Law No. 216.

To widen a certain Road therein described
in the Township of Augustus.

Whereas Edward B Birks, Surveyor of
Highways in the Township of Augustus, has been
petitioned by twelve Freeholders of the said Township
to survey and widen a certain Road; and
whereas the said Edward B Birks has surveyed
and widened out said Road and made his
Report thereon and that the said Road is surveyed
and described as follows, that is to say, commencing
in the west side line of Lot Number Twenty
three near "Heamah's" Mill then running easterly
on the old Road across Lots No. 23, 22, 21, 20, 19,
Center Common and 18 until it intersects the
Concession Road between the third and fourth
Concessions, and the said Road is laid out thirty
feet in width and marked out by stakes planted
in the open ground, and due public notice has been
given of the said survey in six of the most public
places next adjacent to the place where the aforesaid
survey has been made.

Be it therefore ordained and enacted
by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of
the Township of Augustus, assembled at the Town
Hall, that the said Road as surveyed and above
described shall be, and is hereby confirmed
and established as a public Highway.

day of December, A.D. 1869.
