

By Law No. 218.

To repeal By Law Number 208 and to divide the Township of Augusta into Electoral Divisions for Municipal purposes.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, assembled at the Town Hall on Wednesday the 18th day of December, 1864, that By Law Number 208, be, and is hereby repealed.

Be it further ordained and enacted, that the Township of Augusta, shall be divided into two Electoral Divisions for the purpose of holding the Municipal Elections therein, and that the first Division shall consist of the front five Concessions, saving and excepting that part of the Center Common in the fifth ^{concession} lying and being in rear of the Town Hall, and the voters in the said first Division shall tender their votes in the East part of the Town Hall, and that Robert E. Brown Esq, shall be the Returning officer for the said first Division. The Second Electoral Division shall consist of the rear six Concessions and that part of the Center Common in the fifth Concessions lying and being in rear of the Town Hall and the voters for the said Rear Division shall tender their votes in the west part of the Town Hall, and that Isaiah Wright shall be the Returning officer for the said Rear Division.
