

By Law No. 231

To raise a certain sum of money for the support of the poor resident in the Township of Augusta.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, assembled at the Town Hall on Monday the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1864 that there be levied and collected on the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township for the support the poor residing there in the sum of three hundred dollars currency.

Be it further ordained and enacted that the said sum of three hundred dollars shall be apportioned by the Township Clerk on all the assessed real and personal property aforesaid and placed on the Collectors Roll for the Township and when the said sum of money shall have been placed on the said Roll, the Collector of the Township shall proceed to levy and collect the said rates or sums of money in the same manner as is now provided by law for the collection of any other rate and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township to be by him paid out agreeable to the order of the Municipal Council of this Township.
