

By-Law No. 245.

To establish a certain Road therein described,
in this Township.

Whereas Edward B Birk's Surveyor of
Highways in the Township of Augusta has been petitioned
by twelve freeholders of the said Township to Survey
and lay out a certain Road, and whereas the said
Edward B Birk's has surveyed and laid out the
said Road and made his report thereon, and that
the said Road is surveyed and described as follows
that is to say, Commencing at the Macadamized Road
there running angling across Lots Numbers 33, 32, 31
30, 29, 28 and part of Lot Number 27 until it intersects
the Road between the seventh and eighth concessions
and the said road is laid out forty feet in width
and marked out by stakes planted in the open
ground, and due public notice of the said survey
has been given in three of the most public places
next adjacent to the place where the aforesaid
survey has been made.

Be it therefore ordained and enacted
by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta
assembled at the Town Hall, that the said Road as
surveyed and above described shall be, and is
hereby confirmed and established as a public
Highway or Road.
