

By Law No. 262.

To raise a certain sum of money for the support of the poor in the Township of Augusta

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta assembled at the Town Hall on Monday the fifteenth day of January 1872, that there be levied and collected on the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township the sum of four hundred dollars.

Be it further ordained and enacted that the said sum of four hundred dollars shall be apportioned by the Township clerk on all of the assessed real and personal property of said and placed in the Collectors Roll for the Township and when the said sum of money shall have been placed on the said Roll, then the collector of the Township shall proceed to levy and collect the said rates or sums of money, in the same manner as is now provided by law, for the collection of any other rate, and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township, to be by him paid out agreeable to the order of the Municipal Council of this Township.
