

By Law N<sup>o</sup> 312

To raise a certain sum of Money to defray the lawfull and necessary expenses of the Township of Augusta for the present Year

Be it therefore ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta duly assembled at the Town Hall on Tuesday the seventh day of September one thousand eight hundred and seventy five that there be levied and collected on the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township to pay the expenses of the said Municipality thereof the sum of one thousand dollars

Be it further ordained and enacted that the said sum of one thousand dollars shall be apportioned by the Township Clerk on all the real and personal property aforesaid and placed on the collectors Rolls for this Township and when the said sum or part of money shall have been placed on the said Rolls the collectors of the Township shall proceed to levy and collect the said rates or sums of money in the manner as is now provided by law for the collection of any other rate and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township to be by him paid out according to the order of the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta
