

By Law No 326

To Authorize the lease of a certain piece of land for a gravel pit.

Be it therefore ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta, duly assembled at the Town Hall on Tuesday the sixth day of June A. D. 1896, that the Recs be empowered to lease from Alexander Black, half an acre of land for a gravel pit, being composed of the Rear part of Lot Number Eight in the second Concession of the Township of Augusta, bounded and bounded as follows, Commencing on the Rear west corner of Lot Number Eight in the second Concession of said Township, taking the width of ten Rods thereof and running a sufficient distance towards the front of said Lot, to comprise half an acre of land, for the sum of Twenty <sup>five</sup> dollars from the fifth day of June A. D. 1896 from thence and running, for the sum of two hundred dollars, the first one hundred dollars to be paid at the time of the execution of said lease, and the second one hundred dollars one year from the fifth day of June A. D. 1896.

Be it further ordained and enacted, That the Recs and Clerk do sign and countersign the Lease now produced to the Council for the above mentioned Parcel or tract of land, and to affix the seal of the Corporation thereto.
