

By Law No 349

For the Appointing of Deputy Returning Officers for the Municipal Elections of A & 1849

- Be it therefore Ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Town of Lowell August duly assembled at the Town Hall on Tuesday the seventeenth day of December 1848
- 1<sup>st</sup> That William Miller is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the first polling sub-division the poll to be held in John Hammond House
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> That Wm Mellisont is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the second polling sub-division the poll to be held in <sup>David & James</sup> Ames shop House
  - 3<sup>d</sup> That Wm Corwin Jr is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the third polling sub-division the poll to be held in Marcus Jarvis House
  - 4<sup>th</sup> That ~~William~~ <sup>Richard</sup> Cotton is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the fourth polling sub-division the poll to be held in Garnetts school House
  - 5<sup>th</sup> That George Longley is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the fifth polling sub-division the poll to be held in old Custom House Warehouse
  - 6<sup>th</sup> That J Wm Walker is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the sixth polling sub-division the poll to be held in Hawah & Stwall work shop
  - 7<sup>th</sup> That Thomas C. Mann is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for the seventh polling sub-division the poll to be held in Robert Fr Leans shop
