

By Law No. 375

To raise a certain sum of money to defray the lawful and necessary expenses of the Township of Augusta for the current year.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Augusta assembled at the Town Hall on Monday the Twelfth day of September ²⁷ 1881 that there be levied and collected on all the assessed real and personal property of the inhabitants of this Township the sum of Fourteen hundred dollars

Be it further ordained and enacted that the said sum of Fourteen hundred dollars shall be apportioned by the Township Clerk on all the assessed real and personal property aforesaid, and placed on the Collectors Rolls, for this Township and when the said sum or sums of money shall have been placed on the said Rolls, The Collectors of the Township shall proceed to collect the said sum or sums of money in the same manner as is now provided by law for the collection of any other rate and shall pay over the same to the Treasurer of this Township, to be paid out by him, according to the order of the Municipal Council of this Township.
